

# Bunny Loves Flowers

## You need

- 15cm square of fabric to stitch on
- Fat Sixteenth of print fabric (front corners & back)
- 15cm square of iron-on-pellon(H630)
- Your favourite threads for stitching  
(I used Aurifil 12wt Cotton Mako Thread - it's equivalent to two strands of DMC Stranded Embroidery Thread)

- Polyester Fill

Finished Size 4½ x 4½ inches

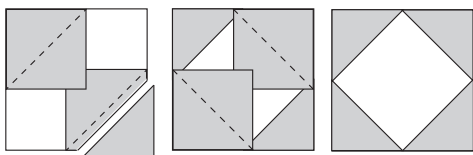
## Cutting Directions

A ¼inch seam allowance is included in the cutting measurements

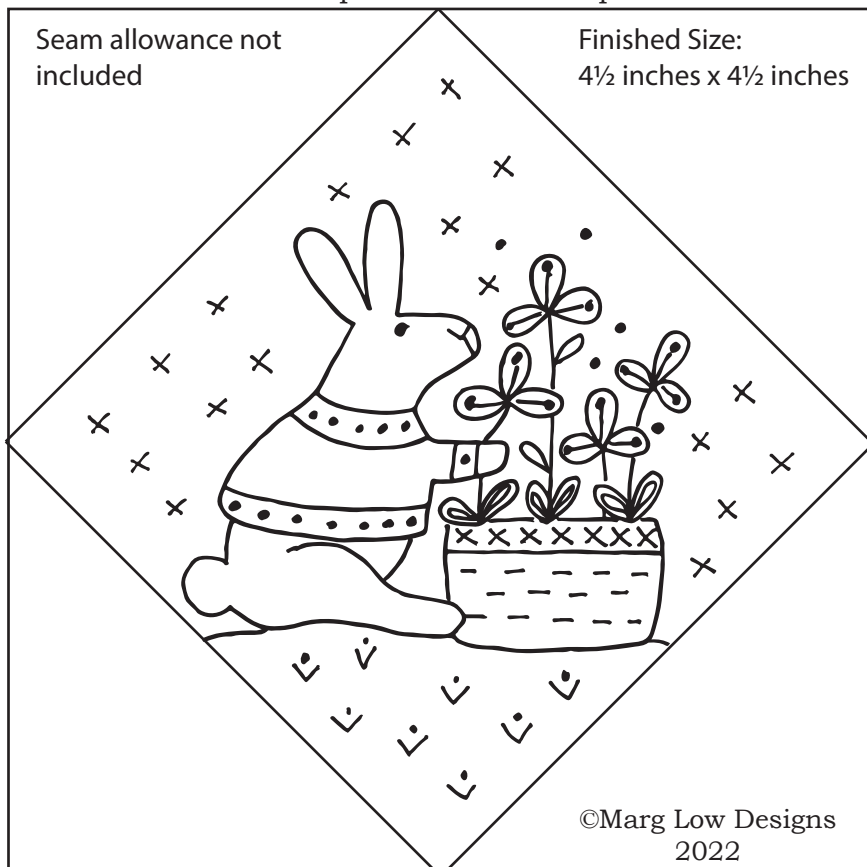
- From the stitchery fabric, one 5 inch square
- From the print fabric - four 2¾ inch squares and one 5 inch square.
- From the iron-on-pellon, one 5 inch square.

## To Make

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 2¾ inch print squares.
- Place them in opposite corners on the stitchery square, right sides together.
- Sew on the line. Trim the seam allowance to a ¼ inch and press the corner open.
- Repeat for the remaining corners.



- Transfer the design using a lead pencil. You may need to use a light source. Small details like the cross stitches and colonial knots may be worked by eye.
- Fuse the iron-on-pellon and front piece together.
- Stitch the design using your favourite threads.
- Pin the front and back pieces right sides together. Sew all sides leaving a 2inch opening in the bottom for turning and filling.
- Turn right sides out.
- Fill.
- Ladder stitch the opening closed.
